Offering a more alternative service to Wong's dream weddings is newcomer Marriage Maestros. "We do gay weddings," says Evelyn Mills, who launched her company in January. While she has had several enquiries, she hasn't actually staged one yet, but she has done a "recognition ceremony" for a local homosexual couple. "It was very private and very small and we had a certificate printed in recognition that the ceremony took place, just something for them to put on their wall," says the 32-year-old.

Marriage Maestros also offers the "whole spiel" to straight couples tying the knot. And they've thought of everything, from setting up the ideal scenario for popping the question to finding the most auspicious date using Tarot readings. They even offer vow renewals a few years down the line.
